

-Ministering in the Gifts of the Spirit -

The primary gifts that surface during this outreach are: the gift of prophecy, word of knowledge, and discerning of spirits, healing, and wisdom but are never limited to these. The Spirit of God endows us with gifts as He wills. I may ask for prophecy, but he may give me understanding and wisdom or a burden to bring healing. Or if I see someone who is injured, I have a responsibility to bring healing, just like if I were to see a demonized man, I have the responsibility to bring deliverance. It has more to do with His supernatural nature inside of me.

Hearing His Voice

Every believer has the ability to tap into God's thoughts toward any individual and any given time because we have been given the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 2:16).

Prophecy

1Corin. 14:3- 3But everyone who prophesies speaks to men for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort

When we go out and prophesy over people's life, we are sharing what God has already spoken in His word about them.

Words of Knowledge

"A divine revelation from God telling or showing what is happening now or what has happened"

Jesus tells the Samaritan woman about her life, and it cause here to repent. (John 4:16-26)

(I.e. I feel a sharp pain, The Holy Spirit could be highlighting that the individual needs healing in that area of pain)

Discerning of Spirits

"A divine ability to see or discern: when the Holy Spirit is moving, the presence of angelic or demonic activity, or the ability to see into the intentions of the hearts" (1 Corinthians 12:10)

Book of Acts, a small girl is following Paul and Silas claiming to give God praise for their visit to her city, Paul discerned her words were inspired by a demonic force. (Act 16: 16-18)

Healing

"While you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus". Acts 4:30

Ministering in lines at your outreach, or everyday on campus you are bound to see someone in crutches, a cast, or a wheelchair, do not hesitate to declare healing and ask to pray with them.

Wisdom

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. (James 1:5)

God desires to speak in knowledge and truth through you on your campus. Know that the Holy Spirit will use you to bring wisdom and understanding that releases comfort, peace, and truth.
